Senior Special Agent Mary Daugherty (ret) has been called the most talented Federal investigator that Richard Harris had the privilege of working with during his 32 years as a Federal prosecutor. Agent Daugherty began her career at ATF with the Arson and Explosive group. Later she worked as an undercover agent for
